- Support industry-wide goals for reducing carbon emissions
- Continue to implement recycling programs and efforts to reduce single-use service items in our operations
- Establish procedures to reduce hazardous waste and prevent and mitigate incidences of spills
- Monitor environmental compliance through internal audit programs
- Promote operational noise abatement procedures to lower aircraft noise
- Comply with rules to prevent the import and export of animals and plants that are detrimental to ecosystems in destinations we serve
